Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

All entries must be submitted online.

Australian Entries Only:

Please note – All Australian entries must be submitted and paid online using Tournament software. **Australian entries close Thursday 25**th **July, 2019,** 23:59 hours BWF headquarters time, (+08:00 GMT hours).

Entry Fees: All players are to pay entry fees.

The entry fee for Australian players is AUD\$100 per player.

The entry fee for International players is USD\$100 per player.

Member Associations will be invoiced after the draw is published.

A Managers Meeting will be held at the competition venue at 5:00 pm, Wednesday 28th **August** (may be subject to change if necessary).

All countries are to ensure they have a representative at this meeting

It is compulsory that all team managers attend the team managers meeting. Failing to attend the meeting, a Member Association may be fined USD\$250 by Badminton Oceania. Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting on

condition the Referee is advised in advance.

Competition Rules and Regulations: The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General

Competition Regulations.

Shuttles: BWF approved shuttles will be used – 2 speeds will be available. Details will be advised at

the Managers Meeting.

Clothing: Clothing and advertising requirements according to BWF GCR. Player name on the shirt is

mandatory (BWF Statutes Section 5.3.7). Country name is optional.

Doping Control: Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted

out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use

Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
