Badminton

Where does the badminton competition take place?

The badminton competition will take place in Telecom Sports Arena Indoor Stadium.

What are the age requirement to take part?

The event will be split into three classifications: 40+, 50+ and 60+

The youngest member of your team will determine which classification you compete in.

The age date is as at the start of the tournament: ie. 21 June 2020

How will the competition be organised?

A team tie consists of 1 x WD, 1 x MD, 2 x XD

If the tie is tied at 2 matches each, a 5th match will be played to determine the winner. The 5th match is a XD, the two players who play must not have played together as a pair already in that tie. This match is to 21 points, sudden death at 20 all, to determine the winner of the tie

In each time one person may only play a maximum of 1 x doubles and 1mixed doubles match

Teams may consist of a minimum of 2 x men and 2 x women and a maximum of 4 x men and 4 x women

All matches will be the best of 3 games, to 21 points with extension to 31 points Each age group will be played in a round robin format. It is the intention that all teams will play at least 4 ties; there may be some days where teams are required to play two ties in one day

If there are insufficient entries in a particular age group, Badminton Oceania may combine age groups to ensure a competition can take place

A full set of rules and regulations will be released by the end of February 2020

How do I enter a team?

The team registration form needs to be completed by ONE person in the team – ie. the team captain. All information regarding the badminton competition will be sent to this person

If I'm part of a team do I still need to register?

Yes, each player needs to register by completing the player registration form and paying their registration fee

A team entry is not accepted until the minimum number of people in the team have registered and paid – ie. 2 men and 2 women

Can I have people come to support me?

Yes, anyone is welcome to come and watch the event. There is no charge to enter the stadium as a spectator.

There is a supporter's package available to ensure your supporters can get transport to the stadium and participate in the social and tourism activities

What days will the badminton competition take place?

The badminton will take place between Monday 22 – Friday 26 June 2020.

Each day will be made up of up to three sessions, while Wednesday 24 June will only consist of one session in the morning to allow for the social excursion – Lagoon Cruise – in the afternoon

Hotel/Resort

How far away is the hotel from the airport?

Edgewater Resort is 3.5km away from the Airport, approximately a 6-minute drive.

How far away is the hotel from the playing venue?

Edgewater resort is 3.4km away from the Telecom Sports Arena Indoor Stadium, approximately an 8-minute drive.

Are there any clothes washing facilities at the hotel?

Yes, communal washing machines are available to use for a small charge, payable at the hotel. Villas include washing facilities.

How do I make an accommodation reservation?

I can't make all scheduled activities, can I pay for a select few? No.

I am attending the event with a non-player, do they need to purchase a different package? If your acquaintance wishes to utilise the transport and attend the social functions and excursion, they must purchase the supporter package. There is no option to purchase the individual components

How can I get from the airport to the hotel?

We suggest you use the service provided by Edgewater Resort – details are available on the booking form.

How can I get around the island in my downtime?

Traffic dependent (although unlikely) it takes approximately 45 minutes to drive around the island. You can get around by hiring a car or motorcycle or using the public transport service.

Car and bike Hire: We will be partnering with a car and motorcycle provider, details available soon. Please note you may be required to purchase a Cook Islands Drivers License for a small additional fee)

Public Transport: A public bus runs throughout the week.

How do we travel from the hotel to the playing venue?

The player and supporter packages both include transport to and from Edgewater Resort and Telecom Sports Arena for all sessions.

A system will be in place to ensure those travelling have purchased a player or supporter package.
