



# COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

## Background

Badminton Oceania (BOC) is one of five Continental Confederations endorsed by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), in accordance with the division recognised by the IOC.

Badminton Oceania shall promote, develop, and regulate Badminton in the Oceania region, in mutual co-operation with support and encouragement of the process from the BWF.

Once an organisation becomes a member of the BWF, it also becomes a member of the relevant Continental Confederation. There are currently fourteen (14) Member Associations (MAs) and three (3) Associate Members of the BWF in the Oceania region, who BOC services.

The BOC Office is located in Ellerslie, Auckland, New Zealand.

BOC is governed by an elected Executive Board and is managed by the Secretary General and other staff.

## Purpose

To clarify requirements for COVID-19 vaccinations for all people when participating in Badminton Oceania activities as part of our health and safety responsibility for participants

## COVID-19 Vaccination

- All Personnel, including staff, coaches, administrators, technical officials, volunteers, and contractors who are involved in a programme or activity (including events) which is connected to Badminton Oceania by way of support (personnel or financial) must be fully vaccinated, including if required by the local health authorities, any booster vaccinations.
- Proof of vaccination to be provided to Badminton Oceania on request.
- Any person who has a medical exemption for COVID-19 vaccinations will be required to provide a negative COVID test within 3 days prior to engaging in such activity
