## ENTRIES

All players in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament will be conducted. The General Competition Regulations of the BWF shall apply.

The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

### All Entries Must Be Submitted On-Line:

All International entries are to be submitted online by the competitors National Badminton Association (MA).

Member Associations are to log onto [Tournament Software and submit their entries online](#).

A username and password are required to submit entries. This can be obtained from the BWF. Please contact Shan Ramachandran at [s.ramachandran@bwf.sport](mailto:s.ramachandran@bwf.sport).

The online entry page will automatically close on Tuesday 13th September 2022 at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+8:00h GMT). Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday (next day of the entry closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Friday 16th September 2022 at 23:59 BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT), the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.

Please note - All Australian entries can only be submitted to BWF by BADMINTON AUSTRALIA.

Australia entries close Thursday 8th September 2022 at 23:59 local time (AEST).

## PRACTICE COURTS

Practice courts are available at the Bendigo-Eaglehawk Badminton Centre from 9:00am, Monday 10 October.

Bookings are to be made via the Practice Court Booking form.

Each player will be provided with two (2) tournament shuttles free of charge at their first practice session.

Competition courts will be available for practice from 2:00pm Tuesday 11th October.

## MANAGERS MEETING

The manager meeting will be held at the Bendigo Stadium, 91 Inglis St, Bendigo West on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> October at 4:00pm.

It is compulsory for all team managers or a member association (MA) representative to attend the team managers briefing session. Failing to attend the meeting an MA may be fined USD250 by Badminton Oceania.

Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting as long as the Referee is advised in advance.

Umpire briefing will follow immediately following the Managers meeting at 6:30pm at the same venue.

## WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals will be managed according to the BWF regulations.

Withdrawals after Monday 26<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022 shall automatically attract withdrawal fees as per BWF regulations.

Withdrawals until this date must be initiated through the online entry system by logging onto the tournament link used for lodging the entry. Withdrawals after that date must be informed by email to the Event Director [poh@bigpond.net.au](mailto:poh@bigpond.net.au) and the Referee [jcudby@xtra.co.nz](mailto:jcudby@xtra.co.nz) as soon as possible.

Withdrawals after the player/s arrive at the venue, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager and/or player to the Referee in person.

## TRANSPORT

Airport transfer for players and officials who are staying at the official tournament hotels arriving at Melbourne or Bendigo airports between Monday and Wednesday (10-12 October 2022) will be provided upon request. For players competing at the Sydney International please note there may be direct flights between Sydney and Bendigo in October 2022. Please complete and submit the Transport Request form no later than Friday 30<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022. Requests after this date cannot be accepted and requests for a refund of taxi or other transport charges will not be entertained.

Transport to practice and competition venues will ONLY be provided to players and officials staying at the official tournament accommodations. Departure flight details after the tournament must be confirmed at least two (2) working days in advance to the Tournament Organisers.

## VISA

If a Visa is required to enter Australia, please complete the Visa Request Form, and return as soon as possible. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for the Visa/s to be processed.

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations and as per the [Badminton Oceania Grade 3 tournament regulations](#).

## **SHUTTLES**

BWF approved Yonex AS30 shuttles will be provided, 2 speeds will be available.

## **CLOTHING & ADVERTISING**

Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 19-23). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all players shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations.

Players should ensure that they read these regulations and that their clothing complies with these regulations.

## **DOPING CONTROL**

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). [For more information about anti-doping, please visit the BWF website](#).

## **BADMINTON INTEGRITY**

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. [For more information, please refer to BWF's website](#).

## **Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9:**

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

## ACCREDITATION

The maximum number of officials and coaches accreditation passes issued to each team is according to the following:

## COVID-19 REGULATIONS
