International entries close Tuesday 20 September 2022 at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarter time, (+8:00 hours GMT).
New Zealand player entries close Tuesday 13 September 2022 at 23:59 local time.



Entries:

All players in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. The competition regulations of the BWF shall apply.

The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

All International entries are to be submitted online by the competitors National Badminton Association (MA).

A username and password are required to submit entries. This can be obtained from the BWF. Please contact Shan Ramachandran at s.ramachandran@bwf.sport.

The online entry page will automatically close on Tuesday 20 September 2022 at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+8:00h GMT) and you are required to submit the entries on time. Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) noon BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 22 September 2022 (second day after the entries closing day) 23:59 BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.

Failing to attend the meeting, a Member Association may be fined USD\$250.00 by Badminton Oceania.

Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting as long as the Referee is advised in advance.



Withdrawals:

Withdrawals will be managed according to the BWF regulations.

Withdrawals after Monday 3 October 2022 shall automatically attract withdrawal fees as per BWF regulations. Withdrawals until this date must be initiated through the online entry system by logging onto the tournament link used for sending the entry. Withdrawals after that date must be informed by email to lisa@bnh.org.nz and the Referee, Sandra David 777sandradaavid@gmail.com. After the player/s arrive at the venue, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager and/or player to the Referee in person.

Practice Courts:

Practice courts at the tournament venue will be available as from 17 October 2022.

Bookings are to be made via the Practice Court Booking form and emailed to the Event Director lisa@bnh.org.nz. Each player will be provided with two (2) tournament shuttles free of charge at their first training session.

Transport:

Airport transfers will be provided from Auckland International Airport to the official tournament hotel upon request. Please complete and submit the flight details form attached no later than Monday 26 September. Requests after this date will not be accepted. Requests for a refund of taxi charges will not be entertained.

Transport will ONLY be provided to players and officials staying at the official tournament accommodation venue, Ramada Hotel, Albany. Transport includes airport pick-up and drop-off, to and from practice and tournament venue.

Departure flight details must be confirmed at least two (2) working days in advance to the Tournament Organisers.

Visa:

If a visa is required to enter New Zealand, please complete the Visa Form and email to lisa@bnh.org.nz. Please ensure you allow sufficient time for the Visa/s to be processed.

Note: all visitors to New Zealand, with the exception of New Zealand and Australian citizens, must apply for either a Visa or a New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA) prior to travelling to New Zealand.

Rules & Regulations:

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the [BWF General Competition Regulations](#) and as per the [Badminton Oceania Grade 3 tournament regulations](#).

Shuttles:

BWF approved Victor Master 1 shuttles will be provided; 2 speeds will be available.

Clothing & Advertising:

Clothing & advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 19-23). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all players shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations.

Players should ensure that they read these regulations and that their clothing complies.



Doping Control:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with the BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match.

Compliance with General Compliance Regulations Clause 7.9:
