Entries close 16 May at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarter time, (+8:00 hours GMT).

Entries:

All players in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament will be conducted. The General Competition Regulations of the BWF shall apply.

The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

All International entries are to be submitted online by the competitors National Badminton Association (M.A).

The online entry page will automatically close on **Tuesday 16 May at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time** (+8:00h GMT). Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday 17 May - noon BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by 17 May 23:59 BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT), the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.

Entry Fees:

The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The Member Association will be invoiced on Wednesday 31 May with payment due by 7 June 2023. Entry fees are due for all players including any who withdraw once the draw is made. Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal.

It is compulsory for all team managers or a member association representative to attend the team managers briefing session. Failing to attend the meeting a Member Association may be fined USD250 by Badminton Oceania Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting as long as the Referee is advised in advance.

Withdrawals:

Withdrawals will be managed according to the BWF regulations.

Withdrawals after 29 May 2023 shall automatically attract withdrawal fees as per BWF regulations. Withdrawals until this date must be initiated through the online entry system by logging onto the tournament link used for lodging the entry. Withdrawals after that date must be informed by email to Roselyn Monroyo <u>roselynmonroyo@gmail.com</u> and the Referee, Peter Cocker - <u>petercwa@iinet.net.au</u>

After the player/s arrive at the venue, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager and/or player to the Referee in person.

Practice Courts:

Practice courts at the tournament venue will be available as from Sunday evening on 12 June 2023 Bookings are to be made via the Practice Court Booking form and emailed to the Event Director roselynmonroyo@gmail.com

Each player will be provided with two (2) tournament shuttles free of charge at their first practice session. Please note that once the tournament commences there will not be any practice courts available

Transport:

Transport will ONLY be provided to players and officials staying at the official tournament accommodation provider: Crowne Plaza Resort Saipan. Transport includes airport pick-up and drop-off, to and from practice and the tournament venue.

Airport transfer will be provided from Saipan International Airport to the official tournament hotels upon request. Please complete and submit the Flight Details form <u>no later than Saturday 3 June 2023</u>. Requests after this date cannot be accepted. Requests for a refund of taxi charges will not be entertained.

Departure flight details must be confirmed at least two (2) working days in advance to the Tournament Organisers.

USA Visa and ESTA:

The Northern Mariana Islands are a USA territory therefore anyone coming to the Northern Mariana Islands must meet USA requirements

U.S.A VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Players and officials whose country are not under the visa waiver program, visit <u>https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/us-visas.html</u> to apply for United States visa.
- 2. Choose Non-Immigrant Visa, B-1.
- 3. Fill out form and submit requirements.

Set up appointment for interview and pay fee.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- → You are a citizen or eligible national of a Visa Waiver Program country.
- → You are currently not in possession of a visitor's visa.
- → Your travel is for 90 days or less.
- → You plan to travel to the United States for business or pleasure.
- → You want to apply for a new authorization for one person or a group of applications for two or more persons.

WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY?

- → Valid passport(s) from a Visa Waiver Program country. List of Visa Waiver Countries
- → Traveler's valid email address.
- → Traveler's home address and phone number.
- → Traveler's emergency point of contact phone and email.

→ Payment method:

Fee for application is \$21.00 USD. Valid payment methods include MasterCard, VISA, American Express, Discover (JCB or Diners Club only), and PayPal.

The following information may also be required:

- → Traveler's aliases or other names (If Applicable).
- → Traveler's National ID or Personal ID number (If Applicable).
- → Traveler's Global Entry ID number (If Applicable).
- → Traveler's employer address and phone number (If Applicable).
- → Traveler's U.S. point of contact name, address, and phone (If Applicable).

Rules & Regulations:

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations and as per the Badminton Oceania Grade 3 tournament regulations.

Shuttles:

BWF approved shuttles will be provided, 2 speeds will be available.

Clothing & Advertising:

Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 19-23). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all the players' shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations.

Quarterfinals onwards GCR 21 regarding clothing colour will apply:

- In Singles matches opposing players must wear significantly different coloured clothing
- In doubles matches both players must wear the same colour clothing and opposing pairs must wear significantly different coloured clothing

Players should ensure that they read these regulations and that their clothing complies with these regulations. **Doping Control:**

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anticorruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matche(s).
