

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

To be completed by any player participating in or attending a BOC led activity or tournament and should be applied in conjunction with any policies the Member Association has in place.

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity, and work of every individual badminton player as a human being regardless of gender, ethnicity, sexual preference, religion and economic status etc.
- 2. Be a positive role model for badminton and act in a way that projects a positive image.
- 3. Be fair, considerate and honest.
- 4. Display high standards in your language, manner, punctuality, preparation and presentation.
- 5. Show courtesy, honesty and respect to all players and staff.
- 6. Be professional and accept responsibility for your actions.
- 7. No form of verbal, physical or emotional abuse will be tolerated including bullying and hate speech; this also covers social media posts and any on-line or digital communication.
- 8. Do not harass, abuse or discriminate against others.
- 9. No junior (u19) player is to leave the Accommodation or Training Facility alone and without a coach present.
- 10. Illegal or recreational drugs are not permitted at any time during the time of the activity/tournament.
- 11. Alcohol, at any time is not permitted to be consumed by junior (u19) players.
- 12. At no time during any Badminton Oceania activity or tournament should any player become intoxicated.
- 13. Adhere to the BOC Social Media Policy.

ANY BREACHES OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT WILL RESULT IN BOC DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES WHICH MAY INCLUDE EXPULSION FROM THE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
