



The Badminton Oceania (BOC) Technical Officials Uniform policy is to ensure the standardisation of uniform

The following uniforms will be issued by BOC to Technical Officials:

BOC Referee Uniform

- 1 x red jacket with BOC Referee logo
- 2 x red polo shirts with BOC Referee logo
- 2 x black casual shirt with Oceania blue BOC logo

BOC Accredited Umpire Uniform

- 1 x black jacket with BOC umpire logo
- 1 x black casual shirt with BOC logo – no pocket
- 1 x black polo shirt with BOC Umpire logo and pocket

BOC Umpires appointed to a tournament outside of Oceania

- 1 x additional black polo shirt with BOC Umpire logo and pocket
- 1 x additional black casual shirt with Oceania blue BOC logo – to wear while travelling

Pacific Umpire

- 1 x Black Shirt with Oceania Pacific Umpire logo
- An additional shirt to be provided if “country uniform” is required at a tournament where an umpire is officiating

BWF Appointed Line Judge

- 1 x black casual shirt with Oceania blue BOC logo

BOC Umpire Assessor

- 1 x black jacket with BOC Umpire Assessor logo
- 2 x black casual shirt with Oceania blue BOC logo

In addition to the above, the following shall be issued to Technical Officials as noted:

BOC Referee

Upon appointment as BOC Accredited Referee they shall receive their Uniform and the following:

- Framed Certificate
- Number Cards for draws
- Set of Red / Yellow and Black cards
- Fixed Service Height Device

BOC Accredited Umpire

Upon appointment as BOC Accredited Umpire they shall receive their Uniform and the following:

- Framed Certificate
- Toss Coin (if not already issued)
- Set of Red and Yellow Cards (if not already issued)

Certificated Referee

- Framed Certificate

Certificated Umpire

- Fixed Service Height Device
- Framed Certificate

Badminton Oceania Line Judge

- Certificate

Any certificates should be presented at an appropriate tournament where their colleagues are present.

Notes:

Umpires and BWF Line Judges who have been issued with a black casual shirt should wear these to Technical Officials briefings. When travelling to an international event, it is suggested that Officials should wear their shirt when travelling to the event for ease of identification on arrival.

Referees should wear the black casual shirt when undertaking venue inspections and any on-site work prior to the commencement of the tournament. Red shirts should be worn to briefings.

The black polo shirt with pocket that is issued to Umpires should only be worn when umpiring non-VICTOR sponsored tournaments or at an overseas appointment when a uniform is not provided.

Presentation of officials is extremely important in order that athletes feel confident in the official presiding over the tournament or their match. When wearing any uniform, unless directed otherwise, any shirt issued, or tournament shirt should be worn with black dress pants or a black skirt and black shoes and socks.

Where an official is wearing a Badminton Oceania uniform of any kind, it is expected that they will adhere to any applicable Codes of Conduct and conduct themselves in a manner befitting a Badminton Oceania official.

It is expected that shirts will be laundered and clean when officiating at any event. If any uniform item requires replacing, please contact the BOC office

The Referee or Event Director will instruct Officials as to which uniform, they are required to wear at any tournament, and it is expected that officials will comply with these instructions.
