1. Entry Details

| Regulations (Conditions of Play) | This tournament will be conducted in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes and <u>General Competition Regulations (GCRs)</u> and the <u>Badminton Oceania Grade 3 Tournament Regulations</u>. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 20-24). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all the players' shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations. Quarterfinals onwards GCR 21 regarding clothing colour will apply: In Singles matches opposing players must wear significantly different coloured clothing In doubles matches both players must wear the same colour clothing and opposing pairs must wear significantly different coloured clothing | | | | |

| Scoring | Scoring will be best of three games to 15 points following the Alternative Laws of Badminton (<u>BWF Statutes, Section 4.1.4</u>), according to which: A match consists of best of three games; a game is won by the side which first scores 15 points (minimum difference of two points). When both sides are 14- all, the side that gains a two-point lead first wins the game. If the score becomes 20-all, the side scoring the 21 st point first wins the game. In the third game players shall change ends when a side first scores 8 points. | | | | |

| Presentation Ceremonies | All prize ceremonies will take place on Saturday 16 August immediately after the conclusion of each final. Trophies will be presented to all champions and finalists.
