2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play)	 This tournament will be conducted in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes and <u>General Competition Regulations</u> (GCRs) and the Badminton Oceania Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 20-24). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all the players' shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations. Quarterfinals onwards GCR 21 regarding clothing colour will apply: In Singles matches opposing players must wear significantly different coloured clothing. In doubles matches both players must wear the same colour clothing and opposing pairs must wear significantly different coloured clothing.
